This is what the Texas HeatWave will commit too:

1. Fly variety of remote control aircraft for 15, 30, 45, or 60 minutes on the following dates _____, _____, & _____.
2. Provide \$5 million liability insurance policy.
3. Fly by ICAS rules.
4. We can fly outside of pilot's meeting planned show time if show problems prevail (low ceiling clouds, other cancellations, etc.) with a 5-10 min. notice (using available/ready planes).
5. Will have static display all day Saturday and most of the day Sunday.
6. Very crowd friendly and will talk, sign autograph pictures, etc. through most of show.
7. Provide own narrator and music.
8. Provide professional Air Conditioned Simulator Trailer.
9. Add and possibly agree to other requests in the comments below.

The following is what we need from the host:

1. No air traffic during our performance. If this is not possible, we need to come to a safe agreement in the comments section below.
2. Need a 1000 foot cube flight performance box with no static display within 300 foot of box (or see comment below for agreement).
3. No vehicular or personnel traffic under show box (or see comment below for agreement).
4. Need to guarantee crowd line barrier 100 feet behind flight box.
5. All team members will have gate and vehicle passes when used.
6. We cannot perform in the rain or in winds above 20 knots or up to 25 knots gust.
7. Most of the team members have jobs and will need to perform our last show (Sunday) before _____ PM and be allowed to break down and leave the show by _____ PM that day. The times are determined by the distance traveled.
8. All payments are due on show date.
9. Please make checks payable (To: Texas HeatWave)
10. We need 6 hotel rooms reserved and paid for by host with two doubles beds in each room. The number of rooms can be negotiated if sleeper trailers are allowed on or next to the airport property. Hotel rooms are needed depending on the distance traveled and where we are on the show line up.
11. Cost agreement:
 - a. \$ _____ Travel Expense (\$2.50/mile round trip)
 - b. \$ _____ Performance Fee (\$450 one day, \$750 two day, or \$900 for three day show)

Important Note: We still have travel cost if bad weather prevents us from performing any or all our duties. For this reason we still need to be paid our travel cost. However, we can negotiate the performance fee charge. Unless specified differently in the comments section we still charge 20% of the cost requirements if the host cancels more than 30 days prior to the show date, 50% if you cancel 2 to 30 days before the show date, and 100% if cancelled the day of or the day before the show date. We generally lose out to other conflicting show date requests and cannot commit to them once we sign a contract.
